Updates

In August, Post 550 wrote a letter to the Bloomington City Council asking them to drop a consideration of a 10 percent city tax on gambling revenue. They dropped the notion, acknowledging it would curtail charitable

efforts and volunteerism within Bloomington. They are considering opening MOA to gambling, not merely the fourth floor.

Presently, Post 550 is facing a rent increase for our office, and we will work out a fair compromise with VFW Post 1296.
